1. BACKGROUND

Heifer International Rwanda (HIR) is a nonprofit international non-governmental organization whose mission is to end hunger and poverty while caring for the Earth through sustainable agricultural practices. HIR works with the Government of Rwanda and other partners to strengthen sustainable agriculture, livestock productivity, farmer incomes, nutrition, market linkages, local capacity, and resilience.

HIR is partnering with the Government of Rwanda, through the Ministry of Agriculture and Animal Resources, to implement the Rwanda Dairy Development Project (RDDP II). HIR invites eligible and qualified companies to submit quotations for the supply and delivery of start-up veterinary drugs, equipment, and related supplies described in this RFQ.

2. Objective and Scope of Supply.

The objective is to procure the required quality and quantity of start-up drugs and related veterinary supplies for distribution to project farmers in fifteen (15) RDDP II districts. The supplier shall provide all specified items, transport them to the designated delivery locations, offload them, and support inspection and acceptance by HIR.

Acceptance	Replace, at no additional cost, any item rejected for damage, expiry, incorrect specification, quantity shortage, or other non-conformity.

4. Delivery and acceptance requirements

Delivery period: complete delivery to all locations within a maximum of 30 calendar days from receipt of the signed contract or purchase order, unless HIR approves a different written schedule before award.

The bidder shall submit a location-by-location delivery plan showing sequencing, transport arrangements and the number of calendar days required.

Quantities, packaging, labels and physical condition will be inspected at delivery. HIR may request reasonable verification of gauge, dimensions, weight, strength class or other stated characteristics.

Ownership and risk remain with the supplier until the materials are delivered, inspected and accepted in writing at the designated location.

Rejected materials shall be removed and replaced within five calendar days of notification, at the supplier's cost.

5. Instructions to Bidders.

Submit the technical proposal and financial quotation as two separate PDF files, both clearly marked with the RFQ number and bidder's name.

Send the quotation electronically to procurement-rw@heifer.org using the subject: ***"RFQ HPI20260904RW – Supply and Delivery of start- up drugs for RDDP II"*** and submitted by **23rd September 2026 at 5:00pm** Kigali time.

Quote in Rwandan Francs (RWF). Prices must include all applicable taxes, insurance, packaging, loading, transport, offloading and every cost required for complete performance.

The quotation must remain valid for 60 calendar days from the submission deadline.

All forms and declarations must be completed and signed by an authorized representative. Pages should be numbered and reference the bidder and RFQ number.

Alternative or partial quotations are not permitted. The tender is one lot and will be awarded as one contract.

Late quotations will not be considered. Bidders are responsible for ensuring that complete files are received before the deadline.

Questions must be sent to procurement-rw@heifer.org by the inquiry deadline. Information obtained from any other source is not official.

6. Administrative Compliance Assessment (Pass/Fail).

Administrative compliance will be assessed on a conformity-to-requirement basis. A bidder must pass every mandatory requirement below. Failure to submit a mandatory document, or submission of an invalid, unsigned or materially incomplete document, will result in the quotation being declared non-responsive and excluded from further evaluation.

8. Financial Evaluation

Financial offers will be evaluated only for bidders that pass both the administrative and technical stages. The contract will be recommended for award to the bidder offering the lowest evaluated total price in RWF, inclusive of all applicable taxes, transport, insurance, handling, and offloading, without compromising the mandatory quality and delivery requirements.

The bidder must provide an itemized price schedule showing, at minimum, each item description, quantity, unit price, total line price, applicable taxes, and the grand total. All required line items must be priced.

9. Technical Specifications and Delivery Schedules

The schedules below show the required items and distribution quantities by province, district, and sector. Bidders must quote for the full requirement unless HIR issues a written amendment stating otherwise.

Equivalent products: Where a brand or trade name appears, it describes the intended product standard. An equivalent may be proposed only when it matches the required active ingredient, concentration, form, pack size, function, and quality. The bidder must identify and document every proposed equivalent.

Condition	Mandatory requirement.
Product condition	All products must be new, unused, genuine, undamaged, and free from defects.
Packaging and labelling	Medicinal products must be supplied in original, sealed manufacturer packaging with legible product name, active ingredient/concentration, batch number, manufacture and expiry dates, storage instructions, manufacturer, and country of origin, where applicable.
Shelf life	No expired product will be accepted. The bidder must state proposed expiry information, and HIR may reject products whose remaining shelf life does not reasonably support the intended project use.
Storage and transport	The supplier must maintain the storage and transport conditions prescribed by the manufacturer and applicable authorities until acceptance at the delivery site.
Inspection	HIR may inspect quantities, packaging, labelling, condition, supporting documents, and conformity

10. Contract conditions

The successful bidder shall provide a performance guarantee equal to 10% of the contract price before contract signature, in a form acceptable to HIR.

Payment will be made in accordance with the contract after satisfactory delivery and acceptance, receipt of valid invoices and all required supporting documents.

No substitution or change of specification is permitted without HIR's prior written approval.

HIR may reject, suspend or terminate performance for fraud, corruption, collusion, conflict of interest, material misrepresentation or breach of applicable safeguarding and ethical requirements.

This RFQ does not create an obligation to award a contract or reimburse any cost incurred by a bidder in preparing or submitting a quotation.

11. Intellectual Property

Section 1. Ownership Generally. Subject to Section 8.2 below, any intellectual property (including but not limited to copyrights, trademarks, service marks, and patents), intellectual property rights, deliverables, manuals, works, ideas, discoveries, inventions, products, writings, photographs, videos, drawings, lists, data, strategies, materials, processes, procedures, systems, programs, devices, operations, or information developed in whole or in part by or on behalf of Contractor or its employees or agents in connection with the Services and/or Goods (collectively, the “Work Product”) shall be the exclusive property of HPI. Upon request, Contractor shall sign all documents and take any and all actions necessary to confirm or perfect HPI’s exclusive ownership of the Work Product.

Section 2. Prior-Owned Intellectual Property. Any intellectual property owned by a Party prior to the Effective Date (“Prior-Owned IP”) shall remain that Party’s sole and exclusive property. Regarding any of Contractor’s Prior-Owned IP included in the Work Product, Contractor shall retain ownership, and hereby grants HPI a permanent, non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide, irrevocable right and license to use, copy, reproduce, publicly display, edit, revise, perform, and distribute said intellectual property, in any format or any medium, as part of the Work Product.

Section 3. Work Made for Hire. To the extent copyright laws apply to the Work Product, the Parties agree that (a) HPI specially ordered or commissioned the Work Product, (b) the Work Product is a “work made for hire” under United States copyright laws, and (c) HPI shall be deemed the author thereof and shall own all right, title, and interest therein. To the extent such rights, in whole or in part, do not vest in HPI as a “work made for hire”, Contractor hereby irrevocably grants, assigns, and transfers to HPI, exclusively and in perpetuity, all of Contractor’s rights of any kind or nature, now known or hereafter devised, in, to, and in connection with the Work Product, and HPI shall solely and exclusively own any and all rights therein, and in the elements thereof, including but not limited to any and all allied, ancillary, subsidiary, incidental, and adaptation rights. Contractor hereby waives any and all rights known as “moral rights”, and any similar rights, which Contractor may have in connection with the Work Product. The description of Services and/or Goods provided in this Agreement shall in no way limit the manner in which HPI may use the Work Product

3. Deliver the awarded items, in the specified quantities, to the delivery points designated by Heifer International Rwanda in the Northern, Eastern, Western and Southern Provinces.
4. Ensure that all medicines are delivered in their original, sealed and properly labelled manufacturers' packaging. Each package shall clearly indicate, as applicable, the product name, batch or lot number, manufacturing date, expiry date and required storage conditions.
5. Maintain the prescribed storage and transportation conditions throughout handling, transit and delivery to preserve the quality, safety and integrity of all items.
6. Comply with all applicable requirements of the Rwanda Food and Drugs Authority (Rwanda FDA) and other relevant national laws and regulations governing the storage, handling, transportation and distribution of veterinary medicinal products.
7. Replace, at no additional cost to Heifer International Rwanda, any item that is rejected, damaged, leaking, defective, incorrectly labelled, expired, short-dated or otherwise non-compliant with the contract requirements. Such replacement shall be completed within seven (7) calendar days following receipt of written notification from Heifer International Rwanda.

8. Provide all required delivery documentation, including delivery notes or goods received notes, clearly indicating the description, quantity, batch or lot number and expiry date of the items delivered, where applicable.
9. Obtain written acknowledgement of delivery from the authorized representative at each designated delivery point.

2. Bidder's Declaration
